# STUDENTS AND APPRENTICES

With the diversity of the yard, the real life hands on experience offered to students is vast. Work based Diplomas (NVQ) are offered at Level 2 and 3 with options of:

- Riding
- Breeding
- Youngstock Training
- Care of the Competition horse



## TRAINING STUDENT PLACES

Students are taken for Work Based Diploma courses (NVQ) Level 2 & 3, although registration is through Carven College the whole qualification is delivered on site. There are no fees for these courses as in most circumstances they are fully funded, all they cost to you is time.

**Part time**:- For students within commuting distance the course can be run three days per week and can be based around any other commitments. This enables students to get a part time job to run alongside their training.

Full time: - We have a limited number of residential places for students wishing to do the course 5 days per week. This self catering accommodation comes with no bills and free Wi Fi. All of our courses are run on a roll on roll off bases, therefore you are not tied to a set start date in the academic calendar. Each student also has their own individual learning plan designed to fit around their strengths and weaknesses. By having their own timescales and targets they are not held back by a group timetable.

Apprenticeship: - We occasionally have Level 3 Advanced Apprentice places available, these are very sought after positions.



We take Equine, Veterinary and Vet Nursing students regularly on work experience placements from a week to whole summer placements. Foreign students can also be catered for.

We also cater for school work experience students

Training with us means that you will have actually foaled a mare, loaded horses on a wagon and groomed at a County Show, not just written about it. Gaining a qualification on such a well known stud also ensures that you stand out from the crowd when applying for jobs. Students graduate with the knowledge and hands on experience to enable them to progress and achieve success in the industry. This is proven by past students who have achieved some top positions both here and abroad, in Australia as mare barn managers, USA in the TB breeding industry, as competition grooms on the Sunshine Tour, as well as head girl/lad posts in Breeding, Showing, Eventing and Show Jumping





# SCHOOL AND COLLEGE DAYS

As well as the regular courses we run listed below we can organise bespoke days for Schools and Colleges which can be tailor made to fit in with any curriculum.

Students who are studying Equine or Veterinary Nursing can also come along to have a taylor made visit to suit their own learning outcomes. Practical and theoretical sessions can take place to allow for all experience levels. These can include practical sessions on stallion management, semen collection and processing, dummy mare training, STI's and testing, faecal egg counting, foaling, mare and foal handling A.I, pregnancy scanning, backing and schooling. On top of any of these, theory sessions can also be carried out in our classroom and can include underpinning knowledge on any of the subjects covered in practice.

We already work closely with a number of colleges who regularly bring students to access our superb facilities.
